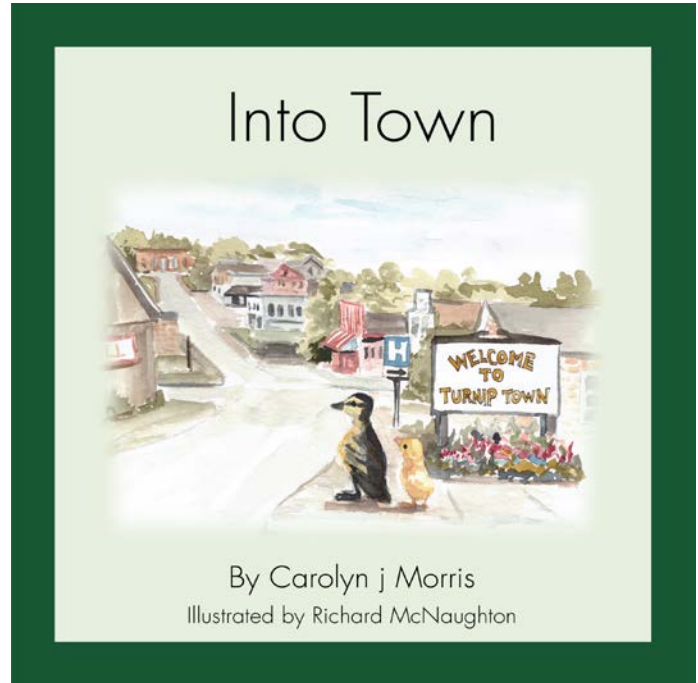

Book Review
